

Albert Tallman Free (1892-1895)

Professor Albert Tallman Free joined the Yankton College faculty in 1888 as a professor of mineralogy, geology, and chemistry. After a prolonged absence of a school president, the Board of Trustees took the faculty's recommendation and picked Free as Yankton College's second president.

Although, Free served only three school years as president, considerable progress was made during his tenure. Ward Hall and the Clarke Observatory had been built, and the college indebtedness had been cleared up.
