

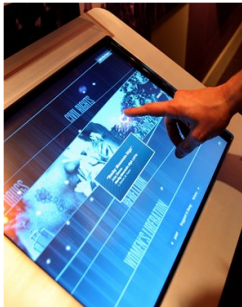

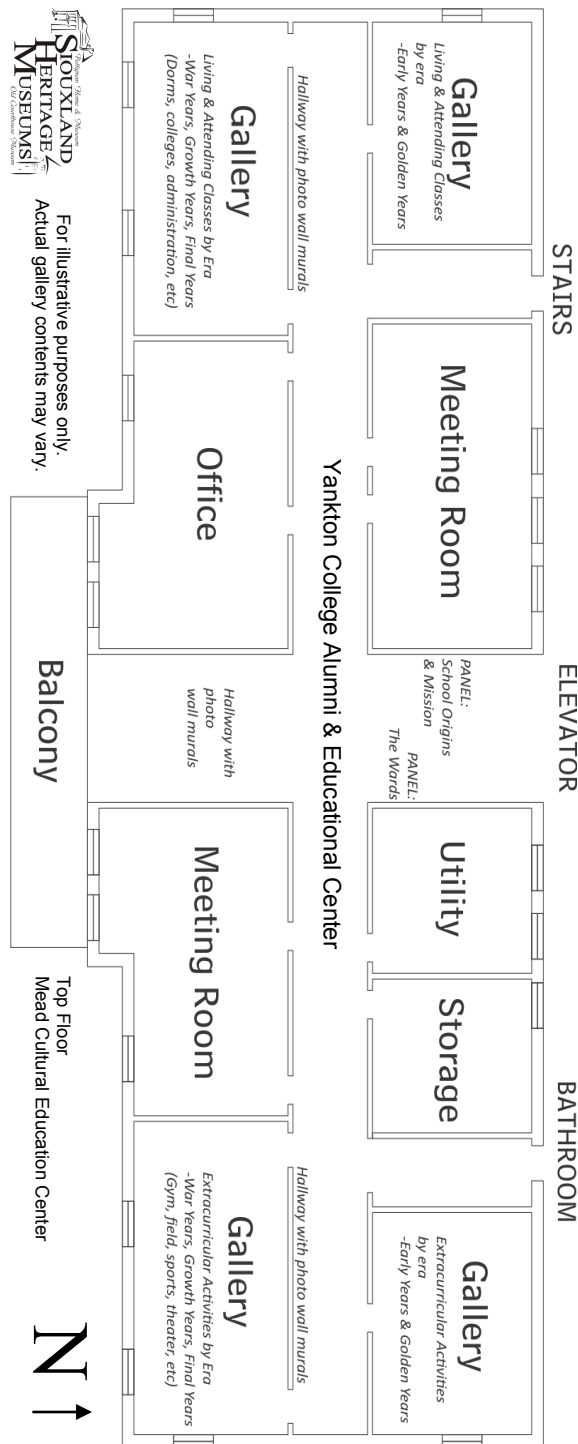

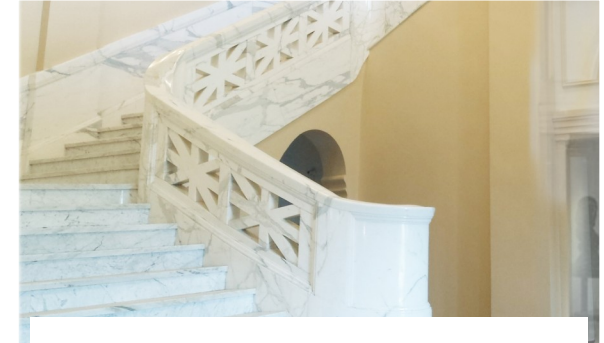

THE HOME STRETCH

From the remarkable generosity of Yankton College alumni and friends, almost \$600,000 has been raised to fund our share of a financial agreement between Yankton College and the Yankton County Historical Society. The Board of Trustees of Yankton College began this fundraising campaign almost four years ago enabling a “buy-in” to establish permanent headquarters of our Alma Mater on the top floor of the historic Mead Cultural Education Center in Yankton. We are so close to having a place where future generations will visit to learn about the college and its legacy.

CROSSING THE FINISH LINE

We will ‘cross the finish line’ with the successful completion of the next phase - the Design Phase of our fundraising campaign - to raise \$250,000 to furnish the Yankton College Alumni & Educational Center. The YC Board of Trustees contracted with Siouxland Heritage Museums for the creative development of Yankton College’s future home. Their preliminary design will be completed for approval before the end of 2019.



THE DESIGN PHASE

The Yankton College Alumni & Educational Center will serve as a museum and repository for a myriad of artifacts and college memorabilia that will share the legacy of the college for generations to come.

The Yankton College story will be told by eras in four galleries and on available wall space using: exhibit cases, pictorial murals, photo panels and interactive touch screen displays. The eras of Yankton College will include:

- The Early Years: 1881 - 1914
- The Golden Years: 1915 - 1940
- The War Years: 1941 - 1953
- The Growth Years: 1954 - 1970
- The Final Years: 1971 - 1984

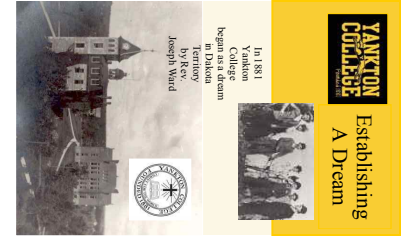
6 WAYS TO MEET OUR GOAL

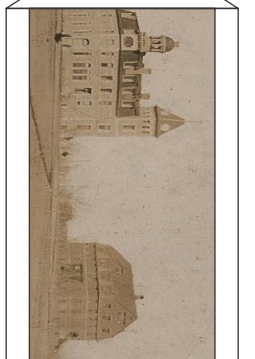
